

Privacy policy

1. Introduction

The Association Rencontre Réconciliation (hereinafter “the Association”) is committed to protecting the privacy of its members, donors, partners and visitors to its website <https://www.rencontre-reconciliation.org>. This privacy policy explains how we collect, use, share and protect your personal data.

2. Collection of personal data

We may collect the following types of personal data:

- Identification information: surname, first name, e-mail address, postal address, telephone number.
- Payment information: if you make a donation or payment, we collect the information needed to process this transaction.
- Browsing information: IP address, browser type, pages visited, length of visit, etc.

This information may be collected when:

- You visit our website.
- You subscribe to our newsletter.
- You make a donation or join our association.
- You contact us via the contact form.

3. Use of personal data

Personal data collected is used for the following purposes:

- Membership management: to manage your membership of the association.
- Communication: to send you newsletters, information about our activities and events.
- Processing donations and payments: to process and manage your donations or payments.
- Website improvement: to analyze the use of our website and improve its content.

4. Sharing personal data

We do not share your personal data with third parties, except in the following cases:

Where necessary to process your payments (for example, with payment service providers).

When we are required to do so by law.

With your explicit consent

5. Data protection

We take appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data against loss, theft and unauthorized access. However, no data transmission or storage method is completely secure. We do our best to protect your information, but we cannot guarantee absolute security.

6. Data retention

Your personal data is retained for as long as is necessary for the purposes described in this privacy policy, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law.

7. Your rights

In accordance with applicable regulations, you have the following rights:

- Right of access: you may request access to the personal data we hold about you.
- Right of rectification: you may request the correction of your personal data if it is inaccurate or incomplete.
- Right of deletion: you may request the deletion of your personal data in certain cases.
- Right to object: you may object to the processing of your personal data in certain cases.
- Right to portability: you can request that your personal data be transferred to another organization in a structured format.
